9 AN ACT TO PERMIT A DISTRICT JUDGE ENROLLED AS A
10 CONTRIBUTORY MEMBER IN THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC
11 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO RECEIVE CURRENT
12 SERVICE CREDIT AS A CONTRIBUTORY MEMBER FOR
13 NONCONTRIBUTORY SERVICE AS A DEPUTY PROSECUTING
14 ATTORNEY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO PERMIT A DISTRICT JUDGE ENROLLED AS A
17 CONTRIBUTORY MEMBER IN THE ARKANSAS
18 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO
19 RECEIVE CREDIT AS A CONTRIBUTORY MEMBER
20 FOR NONCONTRIBUTORY SERVICE AS A DEPUTY

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, is amended
28 to add an additional section to read as follows:

29 24-4-750. Purchase of noncontributory service time by district judges.

30 (a)(1) Any district judge enrolled in the Arkansas Public Employees'
31 Retirement System as a contributory member who was enrolled in the system as
32 a noncontributory member while serving as a deputy prosecuting attorney may
33 apply for and receive current service credit as a contributory member for
34 service rendered as a deputy prosecuting attorney.

35 (2) The district judge shall receive current service credit as a
36 contributory member for service rendered as a deputy prosecuting attorney



1 only if the employee or employer pays or causes to be paid to the Arkansas
2 Public Employees' Retirement System Fund:

3 (A) All necessary employer contributions and employee
4 contributions, if applicable, that would have been paid had the district
5 judge been a contributory member of the system while serving as a deputy
6 prosecuting attorney; and

7 (B) Interest on the contributions under subdivision
8 (a)(2)(A) of this section at the rate directed by the Board of Trustees of
9 the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System.

10 (3) The employer's contributions and employees' contributions,
11 if applicable, shall be transmitted to the system in the form and manner,
12 together with the supporting data, that the board prescribes.

13 (b) The employer may pay the employer contributions and employee
14 contributions, if applicable, on behalf of the employee for services
15 rendered.
