19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-97-102(b)(2), concerning levels of
22 practice of psychology, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read
23 as follows:

24 (D) A person will be privileged to practice independently,
25 if the person:

26 (i) Meets the qualifications set forth in subsection
27 (b) of this section; and

28 (ii)(a) Has completed three (3) years of full-time
29 experience under the supervision of a licensed psychologist; or

30 (b) On a determination by the Arkansas
31 Psychology Board, has received the equivalent of three (3) years of full-time
32 experience under the supervision of a licensed psychologist.

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-97-303, concerning qualifications for
35 licensure as a psychological examiner, is amended to read as follows:

36 (d) A person will be privileged to practice independently, if the

2 (1) Meets the qualifications set forth in subsection (b) of this
3 section; and

4 (2)(A) Has completed three (3) years of full-time experience
5 under the supervision of a licensed psychologist; or

6 (B) On a determination by the Arkansas Psychology Board,
7 has received the equivalent of three (3) years of full-time experience under
8 the supervision of a licensed psychologist.
