- 7 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
- 8 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding
- 9 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 10 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 11 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
- 12 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
- 13 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 14 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
- 15 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
- 16 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
- 17 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
- 18 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
- 19 set forth in (1) above;
- 20 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 21 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 22 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 23 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 24 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 25 <u>days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents</u>
- 26 <u>its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget</u>
- 27 Committee; and
- 28 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 29 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
- 30 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 31 Institution.

35 SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CAFR

- 1 APPROPRIATION. Because the audit of the State's financial statements is
- 2 essential to provide adequate information to the General Assembly to
- 3 determine the needs and legislative requirements of the state, to provide
- 4 adequate information to the Governor for proper management of the affairs of
- 5 the State, and to issue bonds from time to time, the payment of the cost for
- 6 securing the services of an independent auditor to audit the State of
- 7 Arkansas' Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR AUDIT) appropriation
- 8 authorized in this Act may be supplemented through the transfer of any other
- 9 appropriations and funds available to the DFA-Management Services in the
- 10 event that the appropriation or funding provided for the audit of the CAFR is
- ll inadequate.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
- 13 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

- 15 SECTION 32. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 16 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 17 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 18 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

- 25 SECTION 33. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 32 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 34 SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
