## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY FOR PURPOSES OF ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER ACCESS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO DESIGNATE THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION A CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY FOR PURPOSES OF ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER ACCESS. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-211, concerning access to records of the Arkansas Crime Information Center, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(f)(1)(A) The Arkansas Public Defender Commission is considered a criminal justice agency for the purposes of Arkansas Crime Information Center access.
(B) The commission shall have one (1) terminal located in the commission's central office from which Arkansas Crime Information Center searches may be conducted.
(2)(A) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Public Defender Commission shall designate one (l) person of the commission staff to conduct Arkansas Crime Information Center searches who shall undergo a background examination prior to having access.
(B) Upon completion of the background examination required
by subdivision (g) (2) (A) of this section, the designated staff member may
