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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-202 is amended to read as follows:
22 12-12-202. Supervisory board - Members - Meetings.

23 (a) There is created a Supervisory Board for the Arkansas Crime
24 Information Center.

25 (b) The board shall consist of ~~fourteen (14)~~ fifteen (15) members:

26 (1) The Attorney General or one (1) of his or her assistants;

27 (2) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or his or her
28 designated agent;

29 (3) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of
30 Prosecuting Attorneys;

31 (4) A member designated by the Arkansas Sheriffs' Association;

32 (5) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of Municipal
33 Judges;

34 (6) A member designated by the President of the Arkansas Bar
35 Association who is regularly engaged in criminal defense work;

36 (7) Two (2) citizens of the State of Arkansas, to be appointed



1 by the Governor;

2 (8) A member designated by the Arkansas Municipal Police
3 Association;

4 (9) The Director of the Department of Correction or his or her
5 designated agent;

6 (10) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of Chiefs
7 of Police;

8 (11) A member designated by the Association of Arkansas
9 Counties;

10 (12) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police or
11 his or her designated agent;~~and~~

12 (13) The Governor or a member of the Governor's staff designated
13 by the Governor, and

14 (14) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Public Defender
15 Commission or his or her designated agent.

16 (c) No member shall continue to serve on the board when the member no
17 longer officially represents the function for which the member was appointed,
18 except the citizen appointed by the Governor, who shall serve for a period of
19 four (4) years.

20 (d) The board, for cause, may remove any board member and shall notify
21 the Governor of the removal and the reason therefore.

22 (e)(1) The members of the board may receive expense reimbursement and
23 stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.

24 (2) The board members shall receive no other compensation,
25 expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of payments except as provided in this
26 subsection.

27 (f) The board shall meet at such times and places as it shall deem
28 appropriate.

29 (g) A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum for transacting
30 any business of the board.

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
