## Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO UPDATE THE DUTIES OF THE  
16 BUREAU OF LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH WITH  
17 REGARD TO LIBRARY SERVICES TO RECOGNIZE  
18 THAT MANY MATERIALS ARE NOW AVAILABLE AS  
19 DIGITAL MEDIA OR THROUGH THE INTERNET.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-303(c)(4), concerning the duties of  
26 the Bureau of Legislative Research, is amended to read as follows:

27 (4)(A) Maintain a limited legislative reference library,  
28 ~~including current publications and data from other states and those~~  
29 ~~publications and data from agencies in this state~~ service for legislative  
30 matters, utilizing print material, digital media, and information available  
31 through the Internet. The bureau shall collect and make available in the  
32 most suitable form information relative to governmental subjects that will  
33 aid the General Assembly and bureau to perform their duties.

34 (B) ~~In addition, the~~ The bureau shall ~~exchange~~  
35 ~~publications~~ cooperate with comparable legislative agencies in other states  
36 concerning the availability and exchange of publications in order that the



1 General Assembly might be fully advised of current developments in the  
2 legislatures of the various states.

3 (C) ~~In addition, the~~ The bureau shall maintain files ~~of~~ or  
4 digital copies of bills introduced at the various legislative sessions which  
5 may or may not have been enacted by the General Assembly;
