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SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Executive

Director - Employees - Office.

32 (a)(1)(A) The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission shall appoint a qualified 33 person to serve as executive director of the commission, shall fix his or her 34 salary, and shall define and prescribe the duties.

(b)(1) The commission shall not dismiss the executive director if the only basis for the dismissal is verbal or written statements or comments made

- by the executive director before a legislative committee or subcommittee with which one (1) or more members of the commission disagree.
- 3 (2) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission 4 shall be in charge of the commission's office and shall devote such time to 5 the duties thereof as may be necessary.
- 6 (3) The duties shall include, but shall not be limited to, the
  7 collection of all fees and charges under the provisions of this chapter,
  8 keeping a record of all proceedings of the commission, and keeping an
- 9 accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed by the commission, all of which records shall be considered as public records.
- 11 (a) The commission may employ such clerical and professional help and 12 incur such expenses as may be reasonably necessary for the proper discharge 13 of its duties under this chapter.
- 14 (b) Except as provided in this chapter, the commission shall maintain its
  15 office and transact its business at Little Rock.
- 16 (c) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only upon passage 17 and approval of this bill through June 30, 2007 2009.

- 19 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CONSUMER
- 21 PROTECTION. Protecting the consumer is a critical purpose of the Arkansas
- 22 Motor Vehicle Commission. Therefore, of the total amount appropriated under
- 23 Section 2 of this Act for the operating expenses of the Arkansas Motor
- 24 Vehicle Commission, seventeen thousand five hundred dollars (\$17,500) each
- 25 <u>fiscal year shall be allocated to consumer protection efforts. The Arkansas</u>
- 26 Motor Vehicle Commission will submit quarterly a written report to Arkansas
- 27 Legislative Council on their Consumer Protection efforts.
- The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission will continue to develop additional programs and procedures that will expand consumer protection efforts.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

- 33 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 34 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 35 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 36 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1	budgetary procedures law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
6	
7	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
8	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
9	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
10	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
11	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
12	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
13	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
14	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
15	
16	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
18	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
19	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
20	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
22	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
23	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
24	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
25	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
26	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
