15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE  
16 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
17 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
24 Motor Vehicle Commission for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum  
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
33 or its successor.

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11 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas  
 12 Motor Vehicle Commission, to be payable from the Motor Vehicle Commission  
 13 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Motor  
 14 Vehicle Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the  
 15 following:

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29 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. Executive  
 31 Director - Employees - Office.

32 (a)(1)(A) The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission shall appoint a qualified  
 33 person to serve as executive director of the commission, shall fix his or her  
 34 salary, and shall define and prescribe the duties.

35 (b)(1) The commission shall not dismiss the executive director if the  
 36 only basis for the dismissal is verbal or written statements or comments made

1 by the executive director before a legislative committee or subcommittee with  
2 which one (1) or more members of the commission disagree.

3 (2) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission  
4 shall be in charge of the commission's office and shall devote such time to  
5 the duties thereof as may be necessary.

6 (3) The duties shall include, but shall not be limited to, the  
7 collection of all fees and charges under the provisions of this chapter,  
8 keeping a record of all proceedings of the commission, and keeping an  
9 accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed by the commission, all  
10 of which records shall be considered as public records.

11 (a) The commission may employ such clerical and professional help and  
12 incur such expenses as may be reasonably necessary for the proper discharge  
13 of its duties under this chapter.

14 (b) Except as provided in this chapter, the commission shall maintain its  
15 office and transact its business at Little Rock.

16 (c) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only upon passage  
17 and approval of this bill through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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19 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CONSUMER  
21 PROTECTION. Protecting the consumer is a critical purpose of the Arkansas  
22 Motor Vehicle Commission. Therefore, of the total amount appropriated under  
23 Section 2 of this Act for the operating expenses of the Arkansas Motor  
24 Vehicle Commission, seventeen thousand five hundred dollars (\$17,500) each  
25 fiscal year shall be allocated to consumer protection efforts. The Arkansas  
26 Motor Vehicle Commission will submit quarterly a written report to Arkansas  
27 Legislative Council on their Consumer Protection efforts.

28 The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission will continue to develop additional  
29 programs and procedures that will expand consumer protection efforts.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007  
31 through June 30, 2009.

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33 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
35 TRANSFER - MOTOR VEHICLE EDUCATION AND TRAINING. For the fiscal year ending  
36 June 30, 2008, and for each fiscal year thereafter, the Director of the

1 Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission may, from time to time as needed, certify  
2 to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount of funds necessary to  
3 transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor  
4 of State, from the Motor Vehicle Commission Fund to the Department of  
5 Workforce Education Fund Account, to provide funds for expenses related to  
6 motor vehicle education and training. In no event shall the amount of funds  
7 transferred under the provisions of this section exceed one hundred fifty  
8 thousand dollars (\$150,000) in any one fiscal year.

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11 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 23-112-205 regarding the Disposition of Arkansas  
12 Motor Vehicle Commission Funds is amended:

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14 23-112-205. Disposition of funds.

15 (a) All funds received by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission shall be  
16 deposited in the State Treasury as special revenues to the credit of a  
17 special fund to be known as the "Motor Vehicle Commission Fund".

18 (b) All expenses incurred in the organization, maintenance, ~~and~~  
19 operation, and motor vehicle education and training of the commission shall  
20 be paid from the special fund, and the expenditure of all funds shall be  
21 subject to the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, § 19-4-101 et  
22 seq., the Arkansas Procurement Law, § 19-11-201 et seq., and other applicable  
23 fiscal laws.

24 (c) The receipts and disbursements of the commission shall be audited  
25 annually by the Legislative Auditor.

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28 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 19-6-424 regarding the Motor Vehicle Commission  
29 Fund is amended:

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31 The Motor Vehicle Commission Fund shall consist of those special revenues  
32 as specified in subdivision (99) of § 19-6-301, there to be used for the  
33 operation, maintenance, ~~and~~ improvement, and motor vehicle education and  
34 training required by the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission in exercising the  
35 powers, functions, and duties as set out in § 23-112-101 et seq.

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1 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
4 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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11 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
