18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF WORKFORCE  
19 EDUCATION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
20 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
26 Department of Workforce Education for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following  
27 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
28 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
29 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
30 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
31 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
32 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
33 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
34 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
35 or its successor.

SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEDERAL MATCHING. The funds appropriated in Sections for ~~19~~ Adult Basic and General Adult Education, ~~20~~ Coordinated Career Education Services, ~~21~~ Vocational Center Aid and ~~22~~ Vocational Start-up Grants and Aid of this Act may also be used to match any available federal funds from any agency in order to provide the maximum amount of money possible for the purposes enumerated in such section.
