AN ACT TO PROHIBIT AN INSURANCE PRODUCER FROM
PERMITTING AN UNLICENSED PERSON TO ENGAGE IN THE
BUSINESS OF INSURANCE ON BEHALF OF THE INSURANCE
PRODUCER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT AN INSURANCE PRODUCER FROM
PERMITTING AN UNLICENSED PERSON TO
ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE ON
BEHALF OF THE INSURANCE PRODUCER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-64-201(a), concerning the prohibition against unlicensed persons engaging in the business of insurance, is amended to read as follows:

(a) No insurance producer, insurer, insurance consultant, or adjuster shall permit any person not ~~so~~ properly licensed ~~as provided in § 23-64-501 et seq.~~ under this chapter to solicit, sell, negotiate, engage, consult, or adjust in the business of insurance on ~~its~~ behalf of the insurance producer, insurer, insurance consultant, or adjuster.
