CARRY FORWARD. 18 Any unexpended balance of appropriation provided in this Act, excluding 19 Regular Salaries, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 20 21 30, 2008, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose 22 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. 23 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as 24 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: 25 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth 26 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding 27 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 28 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 29 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 30 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 31 32 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which 33 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the 34 35 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request

- 1 set forth in (1) above;
- 2 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 3 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 4 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 5 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 6 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 7 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 8 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 9 Committee; and
- 10 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 11 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
- 12 <u>and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or</u>
- 13 Institution.
- 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 15 <u>through June 30, 2009</u>.

- 17 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
- NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 19 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 20 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Office of
- 21 Attorney General is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item
- 22 authorized in Section 3 Appropriation Operations of the Office of Attorney
- 23 General in this Act to any other line item authorized in Section 3.
- 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 25 <u>through June 30, 2009</u>.

- 27 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 30 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1	SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
2	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
3	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
4	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
5	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
7	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
8	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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10	SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
16	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
17	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
18	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
19	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
20	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
