1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 2 TRANSFERS. During each month of the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, and each month thereafter, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 3 4 transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State, 5 two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) from the Miscellaneous Agencies 6 Fund Account to the Student Assistance Revolving Loan Fund. Transfers from 7 the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to the Student Assistance Revolving 8 Loan Fund shall not exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in any one 9 fiscal year. In the event there is a reduction in the official state 10 forecast, the amount transferred each month from the Miscellaneous Agencies 11 Fund Account to the Student Assistance Revolving Loan Fund shall be reduced by the same proportional percentage as the other funds and fund accounts. 12 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009. 14 15

16 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 18 19 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 31 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34

35 <u>SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General
36 <u>Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the</u>

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1	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the		
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
