32	(2) One (1) member shall be a licensed electrologist;
33	(3) One (1) member shall be an owner of a licensed school of
34	cosmetology; and
35	(4) One (1) member shall be a licensed instructor who is not an
36	owner of a licensed school of cosmetology.

2	appointed from any one (1) congressional district.
3	(3)(A) One (1) member of the board shall represent the elderly.

22	(f) Not more than three (3) members of the board may be appointed from
23	any one (1) congressional district. The consumer representative may be
24	appointed from the state at large.
25	(e)(g) Vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for the
26	unexpired term.
27	(d)(h) Before entering upon the discharge of his or her duties, each
28	member shall make and file with the Secretary of State the oath of office
29	prescribed by Arkansas Constitution, Article 19, § 20.
30	(e)(i) Each member of the board may receive expense reimbursement and
31	stipends in accordance with \S 25-16-901 et seq. All compensation and
32	necessary traveling expenses shall be paid by the board out of the
33	Cosmetology Operating Fund only.
