35	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
36	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that because of issues and	

1	widespread problems that have arisen with the current composition and
2	requirements of the State Board of Cosmetology, this act changes the
3	composition and requirements of the board; that the public has spoken clearly
4	on these needed changes; and that this act is necessary because deficiencies
5	in the cosmetology industry require immediate redress. Therefore, an
6	emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
7	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
8	<u>on:</u>
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
10	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
11	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
12	<pre>bill; or</pre>
13	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
14	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
15	
16	SECTION 3. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. On the effective date of this act, a
17	current member of the State Board of Cosmetology who meets the requirements
18	of this act shall continue to serve the remainder of his or her term. If a
19	current member does not meet the requirements of this act, the member shall
20	be replaced by appointment of the Governor within sixty (60) days.
