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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-15-811 is amended to read as follows:			
20	14-15-811. Continuing education - Board and fund.			
21	(a) There is created the County Treasurer's Continuing Education			
22	Board, which shall be composed of the following six (6) members:			
23	(1) Four (4) members of the County Treasurer's Association,			
24	designated by the County Treasurer's Association;			
25	(2) One (1) member designated by the Association of Arkansas			
26	Counties; and

29	(b)(1) It shall be the responsibility of the County Treasurer's			
30	Continuing Education Board to establish a continuing education program for

- 7 (2)(A) The quorum court of each county shall annually
- 8 appropriate and pay into the fund in the State Treasury the sum of four
- 9 hundred fifty dollars (\$450) six hundred dollars (\$600) from fees of the
- 10 office of county treasurer.
- 11 (B) If any quorum court shall fail or refuse to
- 12 appropriate and pay over the funds to the County Treasurer's Continuing
- 13 Education Fund in the State Treasury, the Treasurer of State shall withhold
- 14 funds from the county aid due to the county and shall credit the funds to the
- 15 County Treasurer's Continuing Education Fund.
- 16 (d) The funds in the County Treasurer's Continuing Education Fund
- 17 shall be used exclusively for the establishment and operation of a continuing
- 18 education program for county treasurers and for paying the meals, lodging,
- 19 registration fees, and mileage at the rate prescribed in state travel
- 20 regulations of county treasurers who attend the continuing education program.

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- 22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-15-1001 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 14-15-1001. Continuing education Board and fund.
- 24 (a) There is hereby created the County Collector's Continuing
- 25 Education Board, which shall be composed of the following six (6) members:
- 26 (1) Four (4) members of the County Collector's Association,
- 27 designated by the County Collector's Association;
- 28 (2) One (1) member designated by the Association of Arkansas
- 29 Counties; and
- 30 (3) The Auditor of State or a person designated by the Auditor
- 31 of State.
- 32 (b)(1) It shall be the responsibility of the County Collector's
- 33 Continuing Education Board to establish a continuing education program for
- 34 county collectors and sheriff/collectors of the various counties in the
- 35 state. This program shall be designed to better equip persons elected to
- 36 serve as county collectors and as sheriff/collectors to carry out their

- l official responsibilities in an effective and efficient manner. The program
- 2 shall include requirements and procedures for an effective certification
- 3 program for county collectors.
- 4 (2) It shall also be the responsibility of the board to disburse
- 5 any funds made available to it from the County Collector's Continuing
- 6 Education Trust Fund to establish and maintain a continuing education program
- 7 and a certification program for county collectors.
- 8 (c)(1)(A) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
- 9 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the County
- 10 Collector's Continuing Education Trust Fund.
- 11 (B) The quorum court of each county shall annually
- 12 appropriate and pay into the fund in the State Treasury the sum of four
- 13 hundred fifty dollars (\$450) six hundred dollars (\$600) from fees of the
- 14 office of county collector.
- 15 (C) If any quorum court shall fail or refuse to
- 16 appropriate and pay over the funds to the County Collector's Continuing
- 17 Education Trust Fund in the State Treasury, the Treasurer of State shall
- 18 withhold funds from the county aid due to the county and shall credit the
- 19 funds to the County Collector's Continuing Education Trust Fund.
- 20 (2) The trust fund shall consist of all moneys required to be
- 21 paid in annually as set out herein, all interest earned from the investment
- 22 of fund balances, and any remaining fund balances carried forward from year

- 24 (d) The funds in the County Collector's Continuing Education Trust
- 25 Fund shall be used exclusively for the establishment and operation of a
- 26 continuing education program for county collectors and sheriff/collectors and
- 27 for paying the meals, lodging, registration fees, and mileage at the rate
- 28 prescribed in state travel regulations of county collectors and
- 29 sheriff/collectors who attend the continuing education programs.

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- 31 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-60-112 is amended to read as follows:
- 32 26-60-112. Disposition of funds collected.
- 33 (a) The revenues from the additional tax levied by § 26-60-105(b)
- 34 shall be deemed special revenues and shall be deposited and distributed
- 35 according to § 15-12-103.
- 36 (b) The revenues derived from the tax levied by § 26-60-105(a) shall

1 be deposited by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration 2 in the State Treasury, and the Treasurer of State shall, after deducting 3 three percent (3%) of the revenues for distribution to the Constitutional 4 Officers Fund and the State Central Services Fund to be used for the purposes 5 as provided by law, distribute the net amount of the revenues as follows: 6 (1) Ten percent (10%) of the remainder shall be distributed as 7 special revenues, as follows: 8 (A) The first sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) ninety 9 thousand dollars (\$90,000) of the remainder during each fiscal year shall be 10 credited to the County and Circuit Clerks Continuing Education Fund, which is 11 established in the State Treasury, to be used for defraying the expenses of 12 training seminars and other educational projects benefiting county and 13 circuit clerks in this state, as provided by appropriations enacted by the 14 General Assembly; and. as follows: 15 (i) Forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) to the 16 County Clerks Continuing Education Fund, which is established in the State 17 Treasury, to be used to defray the expenses of training seminars and other educational projects benefiting county clerks in this state, as provided by 18 19 appropriations enacted by the General Assembly; and 20 (ii) Forty-five thousand (\$45,000) to the Circuit Clerks Continuing Education Fund, which is established in the State Treasury, 21 22 to be used to defray the expenses of training seminars and other educational 23 projects benefiting circuit clerks in this state, as provided by 24 appropriations enacted by the General Assembly; and 25 (B) The remainder of the ten percent (10%) of the 26 remainder available for distribution during each fiscal year shall be 27 credited as special revenues to the County Aid Fund, to be distributed in the 28 manner provided by law to the circuit clerk in the county in which the 29 property upon which the tax is paid is situated, to be paid over by the 30 circuit clerk to the county general fund; 31 (2) Ninety percent (90%) of the remainder of the revenues shall 32 be distributed as follows: 33 (A) The entire amount collected during each fiscal year 34 until there has been collected an amount of such tax equaling the amount of 35 tax collected under this chapter during fiscal year 1982-1983 shall be

credited as general revenues to be allocated to the various funds

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     participating in the distribution of general revenues in the amount of each
     such fund as provided by and to be used for the respective purposes set forth
     in the Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.; and
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                       (B)(i) After making the distribution of the revenues as
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     provided in subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section, the remainder available
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     each fiscal year shall be credited as special revenues to the Administration
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     of Justice Fund to be used for supplementing moneys in the Administration of
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     Justice Fund for court reporter salaries and expenses in the event that the
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     moneys available in the Court Reporters Fund are inadequate during any fiscal
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     year to make the necessary payments for salary and related expenses of the
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     various court reporters of the state.
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                             (ii) Any amount received over and above this amount
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     shall be credited as special revenues to the County Aid Fund.
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
