25	refund as provided under subsection (b) of this section upon presentation to	
26	the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration of proof	
27	of payment to the Revenue Division prior to the effective date of this act.	
28	(b)(l) The refund for a special license plate created and issued under	
29	§ 27-15-5004 is the amount of the fee that was actually paid.	
30	(2) The refund for the annual renewal of the special license

34	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
35	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that due to conflicting laws from	
36	the 2005 Regular Session of the 85 <sup>th</sup> General Assembly, persons who were	

Т	eligible for the special Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate were			
2	charged a fee and other special license plate holders who were veterans were			
3	not charged a fee; that this was a mistake that must be corrected; and that			
4	this act is immediately necessary to ensure similar treatment of all veterans			
5	to prevent unequal treatment of all veterans regarding special license			
6	plates. Ther	efore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
7	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall			
8	become effective on:			
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
10	<u>(</u>	2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
11	the expiratio	n of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
12	bill; or			
13	<u>(</u>	3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
14	overridden, t	he date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
