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31 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 32 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following 33 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra 34 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10) 35 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed 36 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its

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1 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 3 4 the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central 5 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing 6 system/services and debt collection of the Office of the Treasurer of State 7 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 26 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006 2008, any 27 unexpended appropriation and funds provided for the Data Processing 28 System/Services line item shall be carried forward and made available for the 29 same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007 2009. 30 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as 31 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth 32 33 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding

34 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

35 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall

report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 36

1 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the 2 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which 3 4 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution 5 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the 6 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, 7 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request 8 set forth in (1) above; 9 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 10 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 11 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 12 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 13 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 14 15 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 16 Committee; and 17 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals 18 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 19 20 Institution. 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2007 22 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009. 23 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 24 25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 27 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 33 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 34 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

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in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

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1	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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7	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
10	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
