22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
34 or its successor.

24 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT
26 AWARDS FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. Monies deposited in the
27 Court Awards Fund each fiscal year shall be used exclusively for motor
28 vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle renovation costs,
29 for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
31 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

33 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
35 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND - MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At
36 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues deposited each fiscal year

1 into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for motor
2 vehicle purchases and or motor vehicle renovation costs for the Department of
3 Arkansas State Police.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
5 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

6
7 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
9 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,
10 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
11 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to
12 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds
13 Transfer" to the Capital Outlay line item contained in the operations
14 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and shall be used
15 exclusively for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor
16 vehicle renovation costs, for the Department of Arkansas State Police; and to
17 request fund transfers from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of
18 Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
19 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
20 Further provided, the Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
21 authorized to request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the
22 Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund.
23 Fund transfers to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be
24 reported to the Arkansas Legislative Council, but do not require prior
25 review.

29 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

31 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
32 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
33 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
34 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
35 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
36 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the

1 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime
 2 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
 3 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~

 7 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
 9 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
 10 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
 11 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.

 18 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM
 20 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas
 21 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer
 22 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 23 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee
 24 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the
 25 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
 26 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
 27 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
 28 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
 29 department, the ~~85th~~ 86th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
 30 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide

 36 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

2 RATES OF PAY. Due to the necessity of maintaining public safety and the
3 highly competitive job market conditions for law enforcement personnel, the
4 Arkansas State Police is authorized special rates of pay for all current and
5 new Commissioned employees up to ~~the~~ pay levels IIM. ~~listed below:~~

6 ~~T039 State Police Trooper Grade 19 Pay Level IIM~~

7 ~~T054 Trooper 1st Class Grade 20 Pay Level IIM~~

8 Commissioned employees who are hired as State Police Troopers ~~will be~~
9 ~~considered Recruits~~ within the grade 19 classification shall be eligible for
10 salary adjustments, to be determined by the Agency Director, not to exceed
11 Pay Level IIM.

12 Current commissioned uniform employees whose salaries were awarded a one
13 time adjustment by Act 1609 of 2003 and whose salaries exceed Pay Level IV,
14 shall not be considered as exceeding the line item maximum of the employee's
15 assigned grade.

16 After completion of four and a half years of employment the Commissioned
17 employee will be eligible for promotion to Trooper First Class, grade 20.
18 After seven and a half years of employment, the employee will be eligible for
19 promotion to Corporal, grade 21. Employees will be eligible for normal
20 promotion increases as they advance to the classifications of Sergeant,
21 Lieutenant, Captain, and Major. Any disciplinary actions taken against an
22 employee may delay the promotional process.

36 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 3 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

 10 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 19 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 24 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 25 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
 26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
