- 26 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 28 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
- 29 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications
- 30 <u>in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to</u>
- 31 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director
- 32 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic
- 33 Recruitment Plan.
- 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 35 <u>through June 30, 2009.</u>

1 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT AWARDS FUND 3 TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or 4 5 motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, agency operational needs and 6 capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Provided 7 however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund shall 8 be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the Department of 9 Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent with governing 10 federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also request a fund 11 transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Arkansas State Police Fund to the 12 Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative 13 14 Council or Joint Budget Committee. 15 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 16 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 17 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 18 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 19 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 20 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 21 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 22 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 23 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 24 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 25 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 26 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 27 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 28 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 29 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 30 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 31 32 through June 30, 2009. 33 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. 36 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, after seeking

- 1 the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to request transfer
- 2 from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds Transfer" to the
- 3 <u>Maintenance and General Operations classifications established in the</u>
- 4 operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may
- 5 be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle
- 6 <u>equipping/renovation costs</u>, agency operational needs and capital improvements
- 7 for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Fund transfers may be requested
- 8 from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund in
- 9 the same amount and for the same purposes as the appropriation transfer
- 10 <u>requested under the provisions of this section. The provisions of this</u>
- 11 section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas
- 12 <u>Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.</u>
- 13 <u>Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of</u>
- 14 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- 15 <u>is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by</u>

- 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR VEHICLE
- 34 ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least
- 35 fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement funds
- 36 deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for

1 motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for the 2 Department of Arkansas State Police. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009. 3 4 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME. 7 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime 8 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to 9 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be 10 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to 11 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable 12 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime 13 14 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be 15 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee. 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 17 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 18 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR 20 21 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby 22 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for 23 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act. 24 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles 25 used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the 26 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles. 27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 28 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 29 30 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM 31 32 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas 33 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer 34 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 35 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee 36 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the

- l beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
- 2 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
- 3 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
- 4 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
- 5 department, the 85th 86th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
- 6 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide
- 7 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public
- 8 employees insurance program.
- 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{1}$
- 10 <u>2007</u> through June 30, 2007 <u>2009</u>.

- 12 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 22 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 31 <u>SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u>
- 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
- 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
