## Subtitle

17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
18 STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
19 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*  
25 *Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following*  
26 *maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the*  
27 *provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code*  
28 *§§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.*  
29 *Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual*  
30 *salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of*  
31 *said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying*  
32 *positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the*  
33 *Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),*  
34 *or its successor.*

3           Current employees whose salaries are awarded a one time adjustment and whose  
4           salaries exceed Pay Level IV, shall be eligible to receive such adjustment,  
5           not to exceed six percent, in a lump sum payment and such payment shall not  
6           be construed as exceeding the maximum salary for the grade.

7           As a pre-requisite to implementation of the rates of pay authorized in this  
8           section, the Arkansas State Police shall submit a salary structure and  
9           administration plan that addresses the recruiting and retention needs of the  
10           Department for approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval  
11           by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

13           Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
14           appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year  
15           is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

34           PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
35           authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications  
36           in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to

1 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director  
2 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic  
3 Recruitment Plan.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007  
5 through June 30, 2009.

6  
7 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT AWARDS FUND  
9 TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund each fiscal  
10 year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or  
11 motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, agency operational needs and  
12 capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Provided  
13 however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund shall  
14 be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the Department of  
15 Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent with governing  
16 federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also request a fund  
17 transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Arkansas State Police Fund to the  
18 Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. The provisions of this section  
19 shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative  
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee.

21 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
22 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

6 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, after seeking  
7 the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to request transfer  
8 from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds Transfer" to the  
9 Maintenance and General Operations classifications established in the  
10 operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may  
11 be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle  
12 equipping/renovation costs, agency operational needs and capital improvements  
13 for the Department of Arkansas State Police. Fund transfers may be requested  
14 from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund in  
15 the same amount and for the same purposes as the appropriation transfer  
16 requested under the provisions of this section. The provisions of this  
17 section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas  
18 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

19 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of  
20 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

4 ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least  
5 fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement funds  
6 deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for  
7 motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for the  
8 Department of Arkansas State Police. The provisions of this section shall be  
9 in effect only from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

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11       SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.  
13 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime  
14 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to  
15 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be  
16 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to  
17 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable  
18 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the  
19 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime  
20 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be  
21 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

22       The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
23 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

24  
25       SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR  
27 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
28 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for  
29 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.

30       Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles  
31 used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the  
32 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles.

33       The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
34 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

35  
36       SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM  
2 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas  
3 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer  
4 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
5 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee  
6 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the  
7 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims  
8 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined  
9 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance  
10 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the  
11 department, the ~~85th~~ 86th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and  
12 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide  
13 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public  
14 employees insurance program.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~  
16 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

18 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
21 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

27

28 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

36

1 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 2 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 3 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 4 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
 5 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 6 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
 7 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
 8 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
 9 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
 10 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
 11 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
