21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Military Department for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number
25 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
26 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CIVILIAN STUDENT TRAINING PROGRAM TRANSPORTATION. Transportation to support Civilian Student Training program activities for juvenile participants and staff may be provided by commercial lease/purchase of motor vehicles not to exceed six vehicles at Camp Joseph T. Robinson. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH CHALLENGE PROGRAM - STIPENDS. Juvenile participants in the Arkansas National Guard Youth Challenge Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the Arkansas National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to exceed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other personal necessities, and a monetary stipend not to exceed two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200) upon graduation from the program to defray costs for additional job training or education. Juvenile participants are authorized to receive uniforms and clothing items as determined by the staff to be appropriate for effective participation in outdoor activities. 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SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MILITARY SUPPORT REVOLVING FUND.

(a)(1) There is created within the Military Department a revolving fund which shall be designated the Military Support Revolving Fund into which shall be transferred or deposited the moneys to be provided by law for the fund.

(2) The fund shall be used by the Military Department to pay reimbursements for periodic, short term personnel augmentation for National Guard Members on State Active Duty for cost incurred in training activities, which shall include but not be limited to goods, supplies, rations, fuel, operating expenses and related costs and expenses.

(b) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a fund to be known as the Military Support Revolving Fund. The fund shall consist of:

- (1) All funds provided for by law for the fund;
 - (2) All moneys received by the Military Department from the United States Army, United States Air Force, United States Navy, Foreign Allied Governments, and Reserve Forces of the United States, Allied Nations and other federal agencies; and,
 - (3) Any and all reimbursements and payments to this fund from any source shall be considered a refund to expenditures.
 - (4) As federal reimbursements replenish this fund, the Agency is authorized to return funds, as necessary, to the Special Military Fund.

SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the State Military Department shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount, if any, of unexpended federal funds for the State Military Department - Youth Challenge Program remaining in the State Military Department Fund. 9 DUTY PAY. The State Military Department is hereby authorized to pay
10 hazardous duty pay to provide special compensation to eligible firefighting

12 occupational exposure. The hazardous duty pay authorized herein shall be an
13 amount equal to five and one-half percent (5.5%) of the annual salary
14 authorized by law to any eligible employee and shall only be made available
15 to the personnel occupying the following positions.

20 Only employees in the above classifications who are one-hundred percent
21 (100%) federally funded and state administered are authorized to receive the
22 hazardous duty pay allowance in an amount of five and one-half percent (5.5%)
23 of the annual salary authorized by law.

24 The amounts received under the provisions of this section shall not be
25 considered as exceeding the maximum authorized annual salary allowance for
26 employees in receipt of such amounts. Such amounts shall be considered as
27 Regular Salary and the Department of Finance and Administration shall adopt
28 the necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this provision.
29 Employees covered by the provisions of this Section shall be eligible for
30 special compensation for hazardous duty only upon a determination by the

6 RATES OF PAY. Due to the necessity of maintaining public safety and the

9 recognize the importance of adopting a formal program for educational and
10 certificate pay incentives to encourage employees to achieve a college level
11 education and advance training. Course selection must be related to
12 obtaining a degree in a department approved discipline and requires continued
13 service with the department for two years after completion of the degree

8 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.

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
