- 20 SUPPORT REVOLVING FUND.
- 21 (a)(1) There is created within the Military Department a revolving fund

- 1 (100%) federally funded and state administered are authorized to receive the
- 2 hazardous duty pay allowance in an amount of five and one-half percent (5.5%)
- 3 of the annual salary authorized by law.
- 4 The amounts received under the provisions of this section shall not be
- 5 considered as exceeding the maximum authorized annual salary allowance for
- 6 employees in receipt of such amounts. Such amounts shall be considered as
- 7 Regular Salary and the Department of Finance and Administration shall adopt

11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
