19	appointment of an additional circuit judges; and that this act is necessary
20	to ensure the smooth, efficient, and timely administration of justice in the
21	counties affected. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act
22	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
23	and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
