and fee for historic or special interest license plates, is amended to read as follows: (c) Upon selling or otherwise relinquishing ownership of an historic or special interest vehicle, a collector may retain possession of the vehicle plate and transfer its registration to another vehicle of the same category in his or her possession, upon payment of one-half (1/2) the fee prescribed in subsection (a) of this section. The special license plate and registration of an historic or special interest vehicle under this subchapter shall not be transferred. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-15-2202(d), regarding the registration and fee for historic or special interest license plates, is amended to read as follows: (d)(1) A vehicle manufactured as a reproduction or facsimile of an historic or special interest vehicle shall not be eligible for registration
