20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-14-813(a), concerning the authority of a  
23 county to regulate unsanitary conditions, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) To the extent that it is not inconsistent with the powers  
25 exercised by incorporated towns and cities of the first class and cities of  
26 the second class under § 14-54-901 et seq., counties are empowered to order  
27 the owner of real property within the county to:

28 (1) Remove garbage, rubbish, junk as defined in § 27-74-402, and  
29 other unsightly and unsanitary articles upon property situated in the county;

31 (2) Eliminate or remove stagnant pools of water or any other  
32 unsanitary thing, place, or condition that might become a breeding place for  
33 mosquitoes and germs harmful to the health of the community.
