## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-14-813(a), concerning the authority of a county to regulate unsanitary conditions, is amended to read as follows:
(a) To the extent that it is not inconsistent with the powers exercised by incorporated towns and cities of the first class and cities of the second class under § 14-54-901 et seq., counties are empowered to order the owner of real property within the county to:
(1) Remove Abate, remove, or eliminate garbage, rubbish, junk as defined in § 27-74-402, and other unsightly and unsanitary articles upon property situated in the county; and
(2) Eliminate Abate, eliminate, or remove stagnant pools of water or any other unsanitary thing, place, or condition that might become a breeding place for mosquitoes and germs harmful to the health of the community.
