TRANSFER 27 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE CHILD CARE DEVELOPMENT FUND. For each 28 fiscal year of the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Workforce Services shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars 29 30 (\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families block grant to the Child Care Development Fund to be administered by the 31 32 Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education, Department of Health 33 and Human Services.
