29 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 30 31 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be 32 implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought 33 the prior review approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Employment Security Department Department of 34 35 Workforce Services is hereby authorized to make transfers from any 36 appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation made by this Act

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 12 13 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 14 15 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 16 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 17 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Workforce Services may operate more 18 19 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Workforce 20 Services authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both 21 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 22 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 23 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 24 25 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 26 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 27 this entire section is void. 28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 29 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 30 31 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTER-AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR 33 NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the 34 35 Department of Health and Human Services and the Director of the Department of Workforce Services (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve 36

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1	up to three million six hundred forty thousand six hundred fifty dollars
2	(\$3,640,650) each fiscal year in State General Revenue appropriated to DWS
3	for the TANF program to be transferred to the Department of Health and Human
4	Services (DHHS) -Division of County Operations in support of Arkansas'

6	Separate State Programs.
7	The Director of the Department of Workforce Services shall provide a
8	report of all transfers made to the DHHS-Division of County Operations to the

11	justification for and the amount of the completed transfers.
12	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

15	SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
17	OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE CHILD CARE DEVELOPMENT FUND. For each
18	fiscal year of the 2007-2009 biennium, the Department of Workforce Services
19	shall transfer the sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars
20	(\$7,500,000) from the state's federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
21	block grant to the Child Care Development Fund to be administered by the
22	Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education, Department of Health
23	and Human Services. The funds shall be used to provide quality child care and
24	preschool education for transitional employment assistance qualifying
25	families and other low-income families for at-risk three- and four-year olds
26	under the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success programs. These funds
27	shall be transferred from the Division of Child Care and Early Childhood
28	Education to the Department of Education, Public School Fund to be used
29	solely for the purpose stated above.
30	If the state match for the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant or
31	the state's Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant is reduced, the
32	amount to be transferred may be adjusted in proportion to the percentage
33	change in the state match or the state's Temporary Assistance to Needy
34	Families grant. The amount to be transferred may also be reduced
35	proportionately if new cost requirements are imposed upon the state as a
36	result of new or revised Temporary Assistance to Needy Families regulations

1 at the federal level.

2 <u>The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007</u> 3 through June 30, 2009.

SECTION 30. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 5 6 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 7 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 8 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 10 11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14

15 SECTION 31. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 20 21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 22 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24 SECTION 32. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 26 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 31 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 34 35
