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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-704(a), concerning powers and	dutie	s of	
20	regional solid waste management boards, is amended to read as follow	7S:		
21	(a) The regional solid waste management boards shall have the	;		
22	following powers and duties:			
23	(1) To collect data, study, and initially evaluate the	solid		
24	waste management needs of all localities within their districts, as	provi	ded	
25	in § 8-6-716, and to publish their findings as a regional needs asse	ssmen	t;	
26	(2) To evaluate on a continuous basis the solid waste n	ieeds (of	
27	their districts and thereby update the regional needs assessments at	: leas	t

1	(5) To petition the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology
2	Commission or the Director of the Arkansas Department of Environmental
3	Quality to issue, continue in effect, revoke, modify, or deny any permit for
4	any element of a solid waste management system located within a district
5	based on compliance or noncompliance with the solid waste management plan of
6	the district;
7	(6) To adopt such rules or regulations pursuant to rules under
8	the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq., as are
9	reasonably necessary to assure public notice and participation in any
10	findings or rulings of the boards and to administer the duties of the boards;
11	(7) To establish programs to encourage recycling;
12	(8) To adopt official seals and alter them at pleasure;
13	(9) To maintain offices at such places as they may determine;
14	(10) To sue and be sued in their own names and to plead and be
15	impleaded;
16	(11) To make and execute contracts and other instruments
۱7	necessary or convenient in the exercise of the powers and functions of a
18	district, including, but not limited to, entering into contracts and
19	agreements with private entities for provision of services;
20	(12) To carry out all other powers and duties conferred by this
21	subchapter and § 8-6-801 et seq.;
22	(13)(A) To enter into agreements with another solid waste
23	management district to allow a district or any person within that district to
24	transfer solid waste into another district.
25	(B) However, notice of all such authorizations shall be
26	submitted to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality within thirty
27	(30) days and shall be incorporated into the district needs assessment in its
28	next regular update; and
29	(14)(A) To authorize a disposal facility within a district to
30	accept the receipt of solid waste from an adjoining district upon request by
31	the generator of that solid waste, provided that the request specifies the
32	disposal facility and the nature and estimated annual volume of solid waste
33	to be received.
34	(B) However, notice of all such authorizations shall be
35	submitted to the department within thirty (30) days and shall be incorporated
36	into the district needs assessment in its next regular update.

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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 8-6-704(c), concerning the adoption of
3	county purchasing procedures by regional solid waste management boards, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	(c) The regional solid waste management boards shall adopt and follow
6	county purchasing procedures, as provided in § 14-22-101 et seq., as the
7	approved purchasing procedures for the districts.
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
