1	27-24-1502. Definitions.
2	As used in this subchapter:
3	(1) "Blue dot tail light" means a red lamp installed in the rear
4	of a motor vehicle containing a blue or purple insert that is not more
5	than one inch (1") in diameter.
6	(2) "Custom vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:
7	(A)(i) Is at least 25 years old and of a model year after
8	<u>1948; or</u>
9	(ii) Was manufactured to resemble a vehicle 25 or
10	more years old and of a model year after 1948; and
11	(B)(i) Has been altered from the manufacturers original
12	design; or
13	(ii) Has a body constructed from non-original
14	materials.

As used in this section, unless the context otherwise 23 requires: 24 (1) "Office" means the Office of Motor Vehicle: and 25 (2) "Street rod" means any modified antique automobile or truck 26 produced by an American manufacturer in 1948 or earlier which has undergone 27 some type of modification, including the modernization of the engine, 28 transmission, drivetrain, interior refinements, and other modifications the 29 builder may desire, which vehicle is to be driven under its own power and is 30 to be used as a safe, nonracing vehicle for family enjoyment. 31 (b) Registration - Fee. 32 (1)(A) Any person who is the owner of a motor vehicle qualified 33 as a street rod may, upon application, register it as a street rod upon the payment of a one-time initial fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each vehicle, 34 35 and thereafter the payment of an annual renewal fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), and be furnished a license plate of distinctive design to be 36
