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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 4, Subchapter 88 is amended to add	a

24	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Fair Gift Card Act	t."

26	4-88-702. Definitions.	
27	As used in this subchapter:	
28	(1) "Debit card" means any card issued by a financial	
29	institution to a consumer for use in initiating an electronic fund trans	<u>fer</u>
30	from the account of the consumer at the financial institution for the pur	rpose
31	of transferring money between accounts or obtaining money, property, lab	or,
32	or services;	
33	(2) "Dormancy fee" or "inactivity charge or fee" means a fee	<u>e,</u>
34	charge, or a penalty for nonuse or inactivity of a gift certificate, sto	<u>re</u>
35	gift card, or prepaid general use card;	
36	(3) "Financial institution" means a state or national bank,	a

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1	state or federal savings and loan association, a mutual savings bank, a state
2	or federal credit union, or any other person that, directly or indirectly,
3	holds a transaction account belonging to a consumer;
4	(4)(A) "General use prepaid card" means a card or other
5	electronic payment device issued by a bank or financial institution that is:
6	(i) Usable at multiple, unaffiliated merchants or
7	service providers or at automated teller machines;
8	(ii) Issued in a requested amount whether or not
9	that amount may be, at the option of the issuer, increased in value or
10	reloaded if requested by the holder;
11	(iii) Purchased or loaded on a prepaid basis; and
12	(iv) Honored, upon presentation, by merchants for
13	goods or services, or at automated teller machines.
14	(B) "General use prepaid card" does not include:
15	(i) A debit card that is linked to a demand deposit
16	account or a share draft account; and
17	(ii) A written promise, plastic card, or other
18	electronic device that is:
19	(a) Used solely for telephone services; or
20	(b) Associated with a demand deposit,
21	checking, savings, or similar account in the name of the individual at a bank
22	or financial institution that provides payment solely by debiting the
23	account;
24	(5)(A) "Gift certificate" means a written promise that is:
25	(i) Usable at a single merchant or an affiliated
26	group of merchants that share the same name, mark, or logo;
27	(ii) Issued in a specific amount and cannot be
28	increased;
29	(iii) Purchased on a prepaid basis in exchange for
30	payment; and
31	(iv) Honored upon presentation by the single
32	merchant or affiliated group of merchants for goods or services.
33	(B) "Gift certificate" does not include a written promise,
34	plastic card, or other electronic device that is:
35	(i) Used solely for telephone services; or
36	(ii) Associated with a demand deposit account.

4	(6) "Service fee" means a periodic fee, charge, or penalty for
5	holding or use of a gift certificate, store card, or prepaid general use
6	card;
7	(7)(A) "Store gift card" means a plastic card or other
8	electronic payment device that is:
9	(i) Usable at a single merchant or an affiliated
10	group of merchants that share the same name, mark, or logo;
11	(ii) Issued in a specified amount and may or may not
12	be increased in value or reloaded;
13	(iii) Purchased on a prepaid basis in exchange for
14	payment; and
15	(iv) Honored upon presentation by the single
16	merchant or affiliated group of merchants for goods or services.
17	(B) "Store gift card" does not include a written promise,
18	plastic card, or other electronic device that is:
19	(i) Used solely for telephone services; or
20	(ii) Associated with a demand deposit account,
21	checking account, savings account, or similar account in the name of the
22	individual at a bank or financial institution that provides payment solely by
23	debiting the account; and
24	(8)(A) "Transaction account" means a deposit or account on which
25	the depositor or account holder is permitted to make withdrawals by
26	negotiable or transferable instrument, a payment order of withdrawal,
27	telephone transfer, or other similar method for the purpose of making
28	payments or transfers to third persons or others.
29	(B) "Transaction account" includes demand deposits,
30	negotiable order of withdrawal accounts, savings deposits subject to
31	automatic transfers, and share draft accounts.
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33	4-88-703. Regulation of unfair and deceptive acts and practices in
34	connection with gift cards.
35	(a) A person shall not sell or issue a gift certificate, a store gift
36	card, or a general use prepaid card that is subject to an expiration date

1	earlier than two (2) years from the date of issuance or sale of the gift
2	certificate, store gift card, or general use prepaid card.
3	(b) A dormancy fee, an inactivity charge or fee, or a service fee
4	shall not be charged on a gift certificate, a store gift card, or a general
5	use prepaid card before two (2) years from the date of issuance or sale of
6	the gift certificate, store gift card, or general use prepaid card.
7	(c) Upon the expiration of the two (2) year time period referenced in
8	subdivision (b) of this section, a gift certificate, a store gift card, or a
9	general use prepaid card may be subject to expiration or a post-sale fee,
10	including a service fee, a dormancy fee, an account maintenance fee, a cash-
11	out fee, a gift card replacement fee, an activation fee, or a reactivation
12	fee, if the following disclosures are printed clearly in a conspicuous place
13	on the front or back of the gift certificate, the store gift card, or the
14	general use prepaid card in at least ten (10) point type:
15	(1) The date on which the gift certificate, the store gift card,
16	or the general use prepaid card expires; and
17	(2) With respect to a post sale fee:
18	(A) The amount of the fee;
19	(B) The circumstances under which the fee will be imposed;
20	(C) The frequency with which the fee will be imposed; and
21	(D) Whether the fee is triggered by inactivity.
22	(d) If the disclosures required by subsection (c) of this section are
23	hidden by the packaging of the gift certificate, the store gift card, or the
24	general use prepaid card, the seller or issuer shall give the purchaser a
25	written statement of the disclosures before the gift certificate, the store
26	gift card, or the general use prepaid card is sold or issued.
27	(e)(1) If a gift certificate, a store gift card, or a general use
28	prepaid card is sold or issued by electronic means, the seller or issuer
29	shall include a conspicuous written statement of the information required by
30	subsection (c) of this section in the electronic message offering the gift
31	certificate, the store gift card, or the general use prepaid card.
32	(2) If a gift certificate, a store gift card, or a general use
33	prepaid card is sold or issued by telephonic means, the seller or issuer
34	shall state the information required by subsection (c) of this section to the
35	purchaser.

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(f) A term or condition disclosed under subsection (c) of this section

1	shall not be changed after the date of purchase or issuance of the gift
2	certificate, store gift card, or general use prepaid card unless the change
3	benefits the holder of the gift certificate, store gift card, or general use
4	prepaid card.
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6	4-88-704. Exclusions.
7	The prohibitions and requirements of this subchapter shall not apply to
8	gift certificates, store gift cards, or general use prepaid cards that:
9	(1) Are distributed pursuant to an award, loyalty, or
10	promotional program and for which there is no money or other value exchanged;
11	<u>or</u>
12	(2) Expire not later than thirty (30) days after the date they
13	are sold and are sold below the face value of the gift certificate, the store
14	gift card, or the general use prepaid card to an employer, or to a nonprofit
15	or charitable organization for fundraising purposes.
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17	4-88-705. Enforcement.
18	A violation of the provisions of this subchapter shall constitute a
19	deceptive and unconscionable trade practice as defined by § 4-88-101 et seq.,
20	and is subject to all the authority, remedies, and penalties granted under
21	those sections.
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
