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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-14-308(a), concerning unlawful actions
24 and penalties under the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Act,
25 is amended to read as follows:

26 (a)(1) It is unlawful for any person not registered, licensed, or
27 certified under this chapter to perform any act for which registration,
28 licensure, or certification is required.

29 (2) A person is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor if the person:

30 (A) ~~Any person acting~~ Acts as an appraiser within the
31 meaning of this chapter without an appraiser classification;

32 (B) With an interest in a real estate transaction
33 involving an appraisal, improperly influences or attempts to improperly
34 influence the development, reporting, result, or review of a real estate
35 appraisal through intimidation, coercion, extortion, bribery, blackmail,
36 threat of nonpayment for services, or threat of exclusion from future
