24	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE EMPLOYEE CLAIMS. There is hereby			
25	appropriated, to the State Insurance Department, to be payable from the			
26	Workers' Compensation Revolving Fund, for the payment of state employee			
27	claims by the State Insurance Department which shall be supplemental and in			
28	addition to those funds appropriated in Section 14 of Act 2036 of 2005, the

35	SECTION 2. COMPLIANC	E WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement	of funds authorized	
36	by this act shall be li	mited to the appropriation for su	ch agency and funds	

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 4 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 18 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 19 20 the State Insurance Department are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 21 insufficient for the State Insurance Department to continue to provide 22 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide 23 the necessary monies for the State Insurance Department to continue such 24 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work 25 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 26 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 27 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 28 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 29 date of its passage and approval. 30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 31 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 32 33 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

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the veto.

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
