20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Title 6, Chapter 10 is amended to add an
23 additional section to read as follows:

24 6-10-121. Classroom reward for students.

25 The Department of Education shall not prohibit a public school or
26 public school district from developing a policy that permits a classroom
27 teacher to use candy or gum as a positive reward for student participation in
28 the educational setting provided that the policy states that:

29 (1) The candy or gum is an individually wrapped single-serving
30 piece; and

31 (2) The total calories provided per serving does not exceed
32 fifty (50) calories.
