## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT AMENDING PROVISIONS OF ARKANSAS LAW  
CONCERNING THE TIME PERIOD BETWEEN THE  
PREFERENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION AND THE GENERAL  
PRIMARY ELECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT PROVIDING ELECTION REFORM FOR THE  
ASSISTANCE OF COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTION  
COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-418(a)(2), concerning early voting, is amended to read as follows:

(2) However, on all other elections, including, but not limited to, general primary and general runoff elections, early voting shall be available to any qualified elector who applies to the county clerk during regular office hours, beginning ~~fifteen (15)~~ fourteen (14) days before an election and ending on the day before the election day at the time the county clerk's office regularly closes.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-7-203(b), concerning the date of the preferential primary election, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The preferential primary election shall be held on the Tuesday ~~three (3)~~ four (4) weeks prior to the general primary election.
