1 assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at the 2 University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of Trustees may make special 3 allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may 4 determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and 5 exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head 6 coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of providing such 7 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary 8 income of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, which is derived from 9 athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars 10 (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each year of the 2005-11 2007 2007-2009 biennium for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten 12 thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during the 2005-2007 2007-2009 biennium for the assistant athletic directors and 13 14 assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to 15 the regular salary of such athletic director, assistant athletic directors, 16 head coaches and assistant coaches, as established herein provided that the 17 amount of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per 18 annum for any one salaried position. Further, if the special allowance funds 19 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas at Little Rock 20 shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact 21 disposition of those special allowances funds. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 23 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 24 25 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
