Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has 3 4 been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional 5 areas. 6 7 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 10 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 14 15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 16 with in disbursement of said funds. 17 18 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
