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6 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE. There is hereby 7 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the

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SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Such appropriation as is authorized in this Act which remains at the end of the first fiscal year of the biennium may be carried forward into the second fiscal year of the biennium there to be used for the same purposes.

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Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

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(1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

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- 1 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 2 <u>report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from</u>
- 3 <u>the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the</u>
- 4 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 5 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
- 6 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
- 7 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
- 8 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
- 9 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
- 10 set forth in (1) above;

- 12 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 13 <u>report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee</u>
- 14 <u>containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written</u>
- 15 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 16 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)

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- 28 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 30 RESTRICTIONS. The appropriations provided in this act shall not be
- 31 transferred under the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-4-522 or the provisions
- 32 of Arkansas Code 6-62-104, but only as provided by this act.
- 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2005}{1}$
- 34 2007 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009.

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36 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 2 PROVISIONS. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act
- 3 may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each
- 4 appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be
- 5 made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the
- 6 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative
- 7 Council.
- 8 The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act could
- 9 be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution
- 10 and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority to transfer
- 11 between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the General Assembly
- 12 has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer of
- 13 appropriations, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General
- 14 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfers by requiring
- 15 prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the transfer
- 16 authority. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council
- 17 is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by
- 18 the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
- 19 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
- 21 2007 through June 30, <del>2007</del> 2009.

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- 23 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 25 POSITIONS. (a) Nothing in this act shall be construed as a commitment of the
- 26 State of Arkansas or any of its agencies or institutions to continue funding
- 27 any position paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement in the event
- 28 that Tobacco Settlement funds are not sufficient to finance the position.
- 29 (b) State funds will not be used to replace Tobacco Settlement funds when
- 30 such funds expire, unless appropriated by the General Assembly and authorized
- 31 by the Governor.
- 32 (c) A disclosure of the language contained in (a) and (b) of this Section
- 33 shall be made available to all new hire and current positions paid from the
- 34 proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement by the Tobacco Settlement Commission.
- 35 (d) Whenever applicable the information contained in (a) and (b) of this
- 36 Section shall be included in the employee handbook and or Professional

- 1 Services Contract paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement.
- 2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
- 3 <u>2007</u> through June 30, <del>2007</del> <u>2009</u>.

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- 5 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 7 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act
- 8 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
- 9 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
- 10 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
- 11 Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,
- 12 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
- 13 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as
- 14 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
- 15 funds.

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- 17 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 19 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds
- 20 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act
- 21 shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was
- 22 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests,
- 23 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
- 24 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration,
- 25 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas
- 26 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and
- 27 adoption.

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- 29 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
- 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 36 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
2	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
