10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS
11 STATE UNIVERSITY - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE
12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2009; AND
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE
17 UNIVERSITY - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES
18 INSTITUTE APPROPRIATION FOR THE
19 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE. There is
26 hereby established for the Arkansas State University - Arkansas Biosciences
27 Institute for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular
28 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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3 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE. There is hereby
 4 authorized, for the Arkansas State University - Arkansas Biosciences
 5 Institute for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-
 6 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 7 appropriated herein for such purposes: *fifty (50)* temporary or part-time
 8 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 9 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 10 for the appropriate classification.

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12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE. There is hereby
 13 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the
 14 Arkansas Biosciences Institute Program Account, for personal services and
 15 operating expenses of the Arkansas State University - Arkansas Biosciences
 16 Institute for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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31 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 33 FORWARD. Such appropriation as is authorized in this Act which remains at the
 34 end of the first fiscal year of the biennium may be carried forward into the
 35 second fiscal year of the biennium there to be used for the same purposes.

36 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as

1 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

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3 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
4 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding
5 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

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7 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
8 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
9 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
10 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
11 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
12 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
13 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
14 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
15 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
16 set forth in (1) above;

18 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
19 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
20 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
21 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
22 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
23 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
24 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
25 Committee; and

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27 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
28 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
29 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
30 Institution.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
32 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

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34 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
36 RESTRICTIONS. The appropriations provided in this act shall not be

1 transferred under the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-4-522 or the provisions
2 of Arkansas Code 6-62-104, but only as provided by this act.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
4 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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6 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
8 PROVISIONS. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act
9 may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each
10 appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be
11 made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the
12 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative
13 Council.

14 The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act could
15 be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution
16 and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority to transfer
17 between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the General Assembly
18 has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer of
19 appropriations, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General
20 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfers by requiring
21 prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the transfer
22 authority. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council
23 is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by
24 the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
25 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
27 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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29 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
31 POSITIONS. (a) Nothing in this act shall be construed as a commitment of the
32 State of Arkansas or any of its agencies or institutions to continue funding
33 any position paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement in the event
34 that Tobacco Settlement funds are not sufficient to finance the position.
35 (b) State funds will not be used to replace Tobacco Settlement funds when
36 such funds expire, unless appropriated by the General Assembly and authorized

1 by the Governor.

2 (c) A disclosure of the language contained in (a) and (b) of this Section
3 shall be made available to all new hire and current positions paid from the
4 proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement by the Tobacco Settlement Commission.

5 (d) Whenever applicable the information contained in (a) and (b) of this
6 Section shall be included in the employee handbook and or Professional
7 Services Contract paid from the proceeds of the Tobacco Settlement.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
9 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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11 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

13 COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act
14 shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
15 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
16 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
17 Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,
18 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
19 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as
20 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
21 funds.

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23 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

25 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds
26 disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act
27 shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was
28 adopted, as evidenced by Initiated Act 1 of 2000, the Agency Requests,
29 Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
30 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration,
31 letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas
32 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and
33 adoption.

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35 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
5 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
6 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
7 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
8 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
9 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
