16 AN ACT FOR THE COSSATOT COMMUNITY
17 COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2007-2009
19 BIENNIUM.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
26 the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the 2007-
27 2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
28 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
29 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
30 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
31 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
32 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
33 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
34 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
35 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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30 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
31 Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the 2007-2009
32 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,
33 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
34 purposes: *eighty (80)* temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at
35 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
36 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate

1 classification.

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3 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
4 to the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be
5 payable from the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas
6 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Cossatot Community
7 College of the University of Arkansas for the biennial period ending June 30,

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23 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to
24 the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be payable
25 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Cossatot
26 Community College of the University of Arkansas, for personal services and
27 operating expenses of the Cossatot Community College of the University of
28 Arkansas for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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10 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

12 PRIORITIES. High priorities of the Cossatot Community College of the
13 University of Arkansas shall be the development and implementation of
14 technical programs designed to:

15 (1) upgrade skills of current employees in service area businesses and
16 industries,

17 (2) to combat illiteracy and English language deficiencies,

18 (3) to increase the number of skilled workers available for employment,

19 (4) to provide leadership for school-to-work programs including cooperation
20 with area public schools, businesses, industries, and labor groups, and

21 (5) to provide the first two years of baccalaureate education transferable to
22 colleges and universities in the general community area of the College and
23 the State of Arkansas.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~
25 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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27 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

29 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged

30 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the

31 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief

32 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December

33 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or

34 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during

35 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.

36 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the

1 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
2 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
3 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
4 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
6 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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8 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
14 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
