2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-601(a)(6)(B), concerning fees for		
3	dealer registration, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as		
4	follows:		
5	(iv)(a) Upon furnishing certification to the		
6	director or a copy of the dealer's license from the Arkansas Motor Vehicle		
7	Commission and upon the payment of one hundred dollars (\$100), dealers		
8	engaged exclusively in the business of buying and selling all-terrain		
9	vehicles, as defined in § 27-21-102, shall be issued certification from the		
10	director for the purpose of assigning all-terrain vehicle titles.		
11	(b) Each dealer location shall be treated as a		
12	separate entity and certification by the director shall be required for each		
13	location.		
14	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of		
15	this chapter, all-terrain vehicle dealers that are engaged solely in the		
16	business of buying and selling all-terrain vehicles shall not be provided and		
17	shall not be authorized to use dealer's license plates designed for any motor		
18	vehicle required to be registered for operation on public streets and		
19	highways.
