21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 15, Subchapter 3 is amended
24 to add an additional section as follows:

25 27-15-316. Disabled veterans.

26 (a) As used in this section, "disabled veteran" means any American
27 veteran who:

28 (1) Has been determined by the United States Department of
29 Veterans Affairs to be a totally and permanently disabled veteran; and

30 (2)(A) Is the owner of a motor vehicle that is used by or for
31 the totally and permanently disabled veteran; or

32 (B) Is issued a motor vehicle by the United States
33 Department of Veteran Affairs under any public law.

34 (b) A vehicle that meets the following conditions is permitted parking
35 privileges in those areas designated for parking only by a person with a
36 disability under the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act, §



1 27-15-301 et seq.:

2 (1) The vehicle must display a disabled veteran special license
3 plate issued to a disabled veteran by the Department of Finance and
4 Administration under § 27-24-204(a)(1), § 27-24-204(a)(2), or § 27-24-
5 204(a)(3), or a valid disabled veteran license plate issued by another state;
6 and

7 (2) The vehicle must be in use for the actual transporting of a
8 disabled veteran.
