21	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-75-108(a), concerning declaration of a		
22	local disaster emergency, is amended to read as follows:		
23	(a)(1) A local disaster emergency may be declared only by the chief		
24	executive of a political subdivision.		
25	(2) It shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess		
26	of sixty (60) one hundred twenty (120) days except by or with the consent of		
27	the governing body of the political subdivision.		
28	(3) Any order or proclamation declaring, continuing, or		
29	terminating a local disaster emergency shall be given prompt and general		
30	publicity and shall be filed promptly with the city or county clerk, as		
31	applicable.		
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
