9 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
10 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
16 AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER  
17 REAPPROPRIATION.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ARKANSAS. There is  
24 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
25 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
26 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and  
27 Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

28 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
29 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the Jacksonville  
30 Senior Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$20,000.  
31

32 (B) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
33 Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the Jacksonville  
34 Boys and Girls Club, in a sum not to exceed .....\$10,000.  
35

36 (C) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in



1 Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the Jacksonville  
2 Museum of Military History, in a sum not to exceed .....\$20,000.

3  
4 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS. There is hereby  
5 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
6 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor  
7 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -  
8 Disbursing Officer, the following:

9 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
10 Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the North Pulaski  
11 Community Complex, in a sum not to exceed .....\$20,000.

12  
13 (B) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
14 Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the Arkansas  
15 Community Foundation (Three Cheerleaders Fund), in a sum not to exceed  
16 .....\$10,000.

17  
18 (C) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
19 Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 1473 of 2005, for state aid to the North Pulaski  
20 Fire Department, in a sum not to exceed .....\$10,000.

21  
22 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CITY OF BIGELOW, ARKANSAS - IMPROVEMENTS.  
23 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration  
24 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
25 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and  
26 Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
28 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1898 of 2005, for state assistance to the City  
29 of Bigelow, Arkansas for infrastructure, sewer and streets, in a sum not to  
30 exceed .....\$400,000.

31  
32 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ARKANSAS. There is  
33 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
34 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
35 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and  
36 Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

1 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
2 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 837 of 2005, for state assistance to the City of  
3 Jacksonville, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed .....\$20,000.

4  
5 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - CITY OF JACKSONVILLE - LIBRARY. There is  
6 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
7 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
8 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and  
9 Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

10 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
11 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 825 of 2005, for state assistance to the City of  
12 Jacksonville, Arkansas for costs associated with the construction, renovation  
13 and equipping of a library, in a sum not to exceed .....\$300,000.

14  
15 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - CLEBURNE COUNTY LIBRARY. There is hereby  
16 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
17 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor  
18 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and Administration -  
19 Disbursing Officer, the following:

20 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
21 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 932 of 2005, for state assistance to the  
22 Cleburne County Library, in a sum not to exceed .....\$50,000.

23  
24 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - REED'S BRIDGE PRESERVATION SOCIETY, INC..  
25 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration  
26 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
27 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Finance and  
28 Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

29 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
30 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 644 of 2005, for state assistance to the Reed's  
31 Bridge Preservation Society, Inc., in a sum not to exceed .....\$10,000.

32  
33 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - STATEWIDE ACCOUNTING SYSTEM. There is hereby  
34 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
35 Officer, to be payable from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund, for the  
36 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, the following:

1 (C) Effective March 2, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
2 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 104 of 2005, for state aid to the Jacksonville  
3 Museum of Military History, in a sum not to exceed..... \$2,901,534  
4

5 SECTION 9. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
6 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
7 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
8 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
9 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
10 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
11 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
12 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
13 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
14 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
15 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
16 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

17 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
18 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
19 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
20 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
21 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
22 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.  
23

24 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
32

33 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous  
36 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or

1 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the  
2 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,  
3 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the  
4 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.  
5 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
8 passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the  
9 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time  
10 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the  
11 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date  
12 the last house overrides the veto.
