9 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
10 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 ARKANSAS HERITAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
16 HERITAGE REAPPROPRIATION.  
17  
18

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - MAIN STREET ARKANSAS PROGRAM. There is hereby  
22 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the  
23 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
24 Department of Arkansas Heritage, the following:

25 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
26 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 716 of 2005, for the Main Street Arkansas  
27 Program, in a sum not to exceed .....\$85,766.  
28

29 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - CONSERVATION TAX  
30 PROJECTS - AMENDMENT 75. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
31 Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Department of Heritage  
32 Fund Account, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage, the following:

33 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
34 Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2005 and Item (06) of Section 6 of Act  
35 2019 of 2005, for Department of Arkansas Heritage Museum/Facility  
36 Construction, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,227,084.

(B) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 227 of 2005 and Item (07) of Section 6 of Act 2019 of 2005, for Special Maintenance, in a sum not to exceed .. \$1,096,701.

SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 227 of 2005, for major maintenance, renovation and repairs of various facilities within the Department of Arkansas Heritage, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,466.

(B) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 227 of 2005, for the construction, purchase and acquisition of materials to build a permanent music stage and for the development of a music sound studio for tourism, education, and cultural enrichment and for other costs in Helena, Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed .....\$5,861.

(C) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 3 of Act 227 of 2005, for renovation of the Mosaic Templars building in Little Rock for the establishment of the Mosaic Templars of America Center for African-American Culture and Development, in a sum not to exceed .....\$7,552.

SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - CENTRAL ADMINISTRATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition, management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed

3 SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - DELTA CULTURAL CENTER. There is hereby  
4 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center,  
5 to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and  
6 Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center,  
7 the following:

8 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
9 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
10 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
11 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
12 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
13 .....\$750,000.

15 SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - DELTA CULTURAL CENTER. There is hereby  
16 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center,  
17 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
18 accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Delta Cultural Center,  
19 the following:

20 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
21 Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 227 of 2005, for land purchase for a museum and  
22 research buildings, in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,273.

24 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - MOSAIC TEMPLARS HISTORIC MUSEUM. There is  
25 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars  
26 of America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, to be  
27 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
28 accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars of  
29 America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, the  
30 following:

31 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
32 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1495 of 2005, for the Mosaic Templars of America  
33 Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise Historic Museum,  
34 in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,211.

35

36 SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - MOSAIC TEMPLARS CULTURAL CENTER. There is

1 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars  
2 of America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, to be  
3 payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust  
4 Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars of America  
5 Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, the following:

6 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
7 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
8 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
9 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
10 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
11 .....\$1,689,050.

13 SECTION 9. REAPPROPRIATION - MOSAIC TEMPLARS CULTURAL CENTER. There is  
14 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars  
15 of America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, to be  
16 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
17 accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Mosaic Templars of  
18 America Center for African-American Culture and Business Enterprise, the  
19 following:

20 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
21 Item (A) of Section 9 of Act 227 of 2005, for renovation of the Mosaic  
22 Templars Cultural Center, and planning and installation of permanent and  
23 temporary exhibits on the site, in a sum not to exceed .....\$75,821.  
24

25 SECTION 10. REAPPROPRIATION - OLD STATE HOUSE COMMISSION. There is hereby  
26 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Old State House, to be  
27 payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and Trust  
28 Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Old State House, the  
29 following:

30 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
31 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
32 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
33 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
34 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
35 .....\$750,000.  
36

1 SECTION 11. REAPPROPRIATION - HISTORIC PRESERVATION. There is hereby  
2 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation,  
3 to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grant and  
4 Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation,  
5 the following:

6 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
7 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
8 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
9 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
10 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
11 .....\$750,000.  
12

13 SECTION 12. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION. There is hereby  
14 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural Heritage  
15 Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources  
16 Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural  
17 Heritage Commission, the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
19 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
20 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
21 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
22 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
23 .....\$734,591.  
24

25 SECTION 13. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION. There is hereby  
26 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural Heritage  
27 Commission, to be payable from the Arkansas Department of Heritage Fund  
28 Account, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural Heritage  
29 Commission, the following:

30 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
31 Item (A) of Section 13 of Act 227 of 2005 and Item (A) of Section 27 of Act  
32 2019 of 2005, for the system of Natural Areas: Land acquisition, Public  
33 Access and Inventory capital project of the Department of Arkansas Heritage,  
34 in a sum not to exceed .....\$155,000.  
35

36 SECTION 14. REAPPROPRIATION - HISTORIC ARKANSAS MUSEUM COMMISSION. There

1 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Historic  
2 Arkansas Museum, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural  
3 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -  
4 Historic Arkansas Museum, the following:

5 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
6 Item (01) of Section 32 of Act 2019 of 2005, for grants for the acquisition,  
7 management, stewardship, or preservation of state owned lands, historic  
8 sites, buildings, structures or objects by the Department of Arkansas  
9 Heritage - Natural and Cultural Resources Council, in a sum not to exceed  
10 .....\$711,316.  
11

12 SECTION 15. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
13 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
14 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
15 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
16 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
17 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
18 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
19 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
20 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
21 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
22 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
23 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

24 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing  
25 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
26 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State  
27 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,  
28 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any  
29 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.  
30

31 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3  
4 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous  
7 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or  
8 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the  
9 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,  
10 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the  
11 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.  
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
15 passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the  
16 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time  
17 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the  
18 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date  
19 the last house overrides the veto.
