## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND § 5-63-201 CONCERNING THE SALE OF CERTAIN TICKETS IN EXCESS OF REGULAR PRICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND § 5-63-201 CONCERNING THE SALE OF CERTAIN TICKETS IN EXCESS OF REGULAR PRICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-63-201 is amended to read as follows:
5-63-201. Tickets to school athletic events or music entertainment events - Sale in excess of regular price.
(a)(1) It is unlawful for any person, corporation, firm, or partnership to sell or offer for sale any ticket to:
(A) A high school or college athletic event or to an athletic or other event held for the benefit of charity at a greater price than that printed on the ticket; or
(B) Any music entertainment event at a greater price than that printed on the ticket or the box office sale price plus any reasonable charge for handling or credit card use, whichever is the greater.
(2) This subsection shall not apply to an institution of higher education that receives funds per ticket above the face value of that ticket.
(3)(A)(i) Except as provided in subdivisions (a)(3)(B) and (C) of this section, nothing in this subsection prohibits the resale or offering for resale via a website on the Internet of an admission ticket at any price
to an athletic contest, or a dance, theater, concert, circus, or other amusement event, if the organizer of the event and the operator of the location where the event is occurring authorize admission tickets to the event to be resold for more than the price printed on the face of the admission ticket.
(ii) If resale under subdivision (a)(3)(A)(i) of this section is authorized, any admission ticket to the event may be resold or offered for resale through any website if the website's operator guarantees a full refund of the amount paid for the admission ticket under each of the following conditions:
(a) The event is cancelled;
(b) The purchaser is denied admission to the event unless the denial of admission is due to the action or omission of the purchaser; and
(c) The admission ticket is not delivered to the purchaser in the manner described on the website or pursuant to the delivery guarantee made by the reseller and failure of delivery results in the purchaser's inability to attend the event.
(iii) A website operator's guarantee under subdivision (a)(3)(A) (ii) of this section shall be posted on the operator's website and a prospective purchaser shall be directed to the guarantee before completion of the resale transaction.
(iv) A refund issued by a website operator pursuant to any condition under subdivision (a)(3)(A)(ii) of this section shall include any service, handling, or processing fees unless the service, handling, or processing fees are declared nonrefundable under the terms of the guarantee.
(B) If authorization to resell an admission ticket for more than the price printed on the face of the admission ticket is not granted by the organizer of the event or the operator of the location of the event under subdivision (a)(3)(A)(i) of this section, a person or an entity shall not resell an admission ticket for more than the price printed on the face of the admission ticket.
(C) A person or an entity shall not resell a student ticket issued by an Arkansas university for a sporting event for more than the price printed on the face of the student ticket.
(b)(l) It is unlawful to knowingly purchase from the original ticket seller a quantity of admission tickets to an event that exceeds the maximum ticket limit quantity posted by or on behalf of the original ticket seller at the point of original sale or printed on the admission tickets themselves with the purpose to resell the admission tickets.
(2) A person or firm is not liable under subdivision (b)(1) of this section with respect to admission tickets for which that person or firm is the original ticket seller.
(b)(1)(c)(1) Any person, corporation, firm, or partnership violating any provision of this section is guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than twenty-five dollars ( $\$ 25.00$ ) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500).
(2) Every sale or offer for sale is a separate offense.
(d) As used in this section, "original ticket seller" means the issuer of admission tickets or a person or firm that provides distribution services or admission ticket sales services under a contract with the issuer of admission tickets.
