3	(C)(i) In accordance with the state's desire to foster
4	educational excellence, in addition to the amounts determined by the General
5	Assembly to be constitutionally adequate pursuant to subdivisions (a)(2)(A)
6	and (B) of this section, and in addition to the funds distributed to school
7	districts pursuant to subdivisions (a)(2)(A) and (B) of this section:
8	(a) For the 2007-2008 school year, fifty-one
9	dollars (\$51.00) multiplied by the school district's average daily membership
10	for the previous school year; and
11	(b) For the 2008-2009 school year, an
12	additional thirty-six dollars (\$36.00) multiplied by the school district's
13	average daily membership for the previous school year, which when added to
14	the funding under subdivision $(a)(2)(C)(i)(a)$ of this section represents an
15	approximate total for the 2008-2009 school year of eighty-seven dollars
16	(\$87.00) per average daily membership.
17	(ii) The additional funding provided by this
18	<pre>subdivision (a)(2)(C):</pre>
19	(a) Shall be distributed by the department in
20	eleven (11) monthly payments from funds appropriated by law and available for
21	distribution as state foundation funding aid; and
22	(b) Shall be known as "Enhanced Educational
23	Funding". The General Assembly has determined that Enhanced Educational
24	Funding provided for by this subdivision (a)(2)(C) is in addition to, and in
25	excess of, the amount of funds necessary to provide an adequate education as
26	required by the Arkansas Constitution. The Enhanced Educational Funding is
27	available from a combination of fortunate economic factors, conservative
28	budgeting of all state government, and the favorable forecast of state
29	revenues. As a result, the enhanced component of Enhanced Educational
30	Funding cannot be ensured and may not be relied on beyond the 2007-2009
31	biennium.
32	(C) For the 2005-2006 school year and the 2006-2007 school
33	year, the foundation funding amount provided under subdivisions (a)(2)(A) and
34	(B) of this section shall be increased by forty-two dollars (\$42.00)
35	multiplied by the district's average daily membership for the previous school
36	year to pay for increased school district costs resulting from the 2005-2006

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1	and 2006-2007 increases in the employer's rate of contribution to the
2	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System from thirteen percent (13%) to fourteen
3	percent (14%).
4	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the 2006 Act 57 adequacy study
6	recommended that foundation funding be increased for the 2007-2008 and 2008-
7	2009 school years; that the method of calculating the state foundation
8	funding aid should be changed to ensure that all public school districts
9	receive the full amount of foundation funding plus an enhanced educational
10	component of additional funding above and beyond adequate foundation funding;
11	and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that public school
12	districts receive said funding for the 2007-2009 biennium. Therefore, an
13	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
14	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
15	effective on July 1, 2007.
