10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE
11 ASSISTANCE TO ESTABLISH, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A
12 STATE VETERANS' CEMETERY IN *CROSS, ST. FRANCIS* OR
13 POINSETT COUNTY FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS'
14 AFFAIRS FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,
15 2009; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - ESTABLISHMENT OF STATE VETERANS' CEMETERY IN
28 *CROSS, ST. FRANCIS* OR POINSETT COUNTY. There is hereby appropriated, to the
29 Department of Veterans' Affairs, to be payable from the General Improvement
30 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, to establish a Veteran's
31 Cemetery in *Cross, St. Francis* or Poinsett County, the sum
32 of.....\$1,600,000.

34 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - VETERANS' CEMETERY IN *CROSS, ST. FRANCIS* OR
35 POINSETT COUNTY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Veterans'
36 Affairs, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for



1 maintenance and general operations of a State Veterans' Cemetery of the
2 Department of Veterans' Affairs for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009,
3 the following:

9 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

11 REIMBURSEMENT OF FUNDS. Any reimbursement(s) received by the Department of
12 Veterans' Affairs for expenses paid from the General Improvement Fund or its
13 successor fund or fund accounts or from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund
14 Account for the establishment of the State Veterans' Cemetery shall be
15 recouped by the State of Arkansas by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
16 and transferred to the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
18 through June 30, 2009.

20 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
21 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
22 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
23 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
31 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
32 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
33 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
34 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
35 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
36 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

1 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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3 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
10 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
