18 REPRESENTATIVES - STAFF APPROPRIATION
19 FOR THE 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - HOUSE STAFF. There is hereby established
25 for the Arkansas House of Representatives for the 2007-2009 biennium, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas House of Representatives for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: seven (7) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STAFF. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas House of Representatives and the staff of the Arkansas House of Representatives for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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11 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - INSTITUTE. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 12 Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional
 13 Officers Fund, for payment of per diem and mileage of members and newly
 14 elected members who attend the Biennial Institute of Legislative Procedure,
 15 House Legislative Orientation, and any other briefing meetings held prior to
 16 the convening of the 2009 Regular Session of the General Assembly, the sum of
 17\$138,000.

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19 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTERIZATION. There is hereby appropriated,
 20 to the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the State
 21 Central Services Fund, for expenses required in continuing the automation of
 22 the legislative process of the Arkansas House of Representatives for the
 23 biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the sum of.....\$500,000.

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25 SECTION 6. REGULAR SALARIES - CONSTITUENCY SERVICES. There is hereby
 26 established for the Arkansas House of Representatives - Constituency Services
 27 for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
 28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
 29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
 30 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
 31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
 32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
 33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
 34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
 35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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10 SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION AND CARRY FORWARD -

11 CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas

12 House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers

13 Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30, 2007 in the appropriations

14 enacted to defray the necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of

15 the Eighty-sixth General Assembly, Section 2 of Act 3 of 2005, Sections 4 and

16 11 of Act 849 of 2005 and Act 3 of the First Extraordinary Session of 2006,

17 there to be used for the same purposes for the Arkansas House of

18 Representatives of the Eighty-sixth General Assembly, in a sum in the

19 aggregate not to exceed.....\$3,757,135

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21 SECTION 12. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION AND CARRY FORWARD - STATE

22 CENTRAL SERVICES FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas House of

23 Representatives, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the

24 balance remaining on June 30, 2007 in the appropriations by Sections 3, 5, 7,

25 9, 10 and 12 of Act 849 of 2005, there to be used for the same purposes for

26 the Arkansas House of Representatives of the Eighty-sixth General Assembly,

27 in a sum in the aggregate not to exceed.....\$3,448,000

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29 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF

31 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the

32 necessary expenses of the operation of the Office of the Speaker of the House

33 of Representatives, the Office of the Coordinator of House Legislative

34 Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief Clerk's Office, House

35 Constituency Services Office and other reasonable and necessary expenses of

36 the House of Representatives of the General Assembly incurred during the

1 biennial period ending ~~June 30, 2007~~ June 30, 2009. Any balance remaining on
 2 ~~June 30, 2006~~ June 30, 2008 in the appropriations and funds provided by this
 3 Act shall be made available for the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2007~~ June 30,
 4 2009 and for the same purpose.

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 6 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 8 AUTHORITY. If the Speaker of the House and the Coordinator of House
 9 Legislative Services determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated
 10 herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such purpose, they may
 11 certify such fact to the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a
 12 transfer to be made from one item to another.

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 14 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES.
 16 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and
 17 retained, the House of Representatives may exceed the maximum salary levels
 18 by no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the
 19 positions authorized in their biennial operation appropriation act, may
 20 exceed the maximum salary levels for the purpose of merit adjustments for all
 21 positions, and may promote a maximum of two grades for no more than one-third
 22 (1/3) of the classified positions authorized in its biennial operation
 23 appropriation act.

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 25 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 35 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
3 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
10 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.

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
