## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to amend arkansas Code § 5-1-110 CONCERNING THE PROSECUTION OF CONDUCT CONSTITUTING MORE THAN ONE (1) OFFENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-1-110(d), concerning offenses for which a separate conviction and sentence are authorized, is amended to read as follows:
(d) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a separate conviction and sentence are authorized for:
(A) Capital murder, § 5-10-101, and any felony utilized as an underlying felony for the capital murder;
(B) Criminal attempt to commit capital murder, §§5-3-201 and 5-10-101, and any felony utilized as an underlying felony for the attempted capital murder;
(C) Murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102, and any felony utilized as an underlying felony for the murder in the first degree; and
(C)(D) Criminal attempt to commit murder in the first degree, §§ 5-3-201 and 5-10-102, and any felony utilized as an underlying felony for the attempted murder in the first degree; and
(E) Continuing criminal enterprise, §5-64-405 and former § 5-64-414, and any predicate felony utilized to prove the continuing criminal enterprise.
(2) Pursuant to §5-4-403, with respect to any offense mentioned in subdivision (d)(l) of this section, the trial judge may order that the multiple terms of imprisonment run concurrently or consecutively.
